OVER 100 PACEs AWARD

NON PERFORMANCE EVENT

- Paces must be accomplished after the end of the NSC the previous year (October 24, 2009) and before September 10, 2010.
- This category will be included in the list of early submissions and is due by 2:00 pm on September 10, 2010.
- Only work accomplished in Paces will count. (no mini-classes)
- Pace work must be on high school level beginning at 1097
- Gaps may be included ONLY if on high school level
- PACE's included must be official curriculum of ACE Ministries/SOT and/or Filipino language. (Philippine History, Asian History and World Economics)
- ACE training PACEs may be included in this award. Certification must come from the School of Tomorrow School Services/Training Division office.
- BLESS training may count towards the Over 100 PACE award. The BLESS training includes eight (8) Paces (referred to as modules). The training must be certified through BLESS office.
- Legible copies of the appropriate Supervisor's Progress Cards with dates of tests taken must be submitted along with application (CF23 see attachment) signed by the principal/pastor.
- This category will earn a gold medallion/1st place award.
